Introduction

The one day interactive course provides a practical introduction to energy management and the skills and knowledge required to implement an energy management system. The course covers the role of an energy manager and the key tools of auditing, monitoring and targeting energy use. As well as the technical aspects of energy management, delegates will learn how to develop a positive staff approach to energy saving and learn strategies for dealing with day-to-day issues. The course delivery is designed around the principles of the International Standard BS ISO 50001 and will be taught by an experienced trainers, energy professionals and auditors.

Course Objectives

- To demonstrate a greater understanding of when and where energy is consumed
- To explain how to implement an energy management system, the key approaches to reducing energy consumption, cost and carbon emissions and describe how ISO 50001 links with ISO 14001

In addition, the course will assist if you are planning to implement an Energy Management System or would like to integrate ISO 50001 into an Environmental Management System, such as ISO14001.
